STCU 59th BOARD MEETING RECORD OF DECISIONS – 09 OCTOBER 2024



The 59th STCU Governing Board Meeting made the following decisions via written procedure:

- Approved the minutes of the 58th GBM held on May 22, 2024, as presented.
- Approved twelve (12) projects for a total of \$942,049 and €14,000,000.
- Approved new U.S. supplemental funding in the amount of \$707,370, with \$622,370 for a new Virtual Short-Term Scientist Engagement Fellowship Program for Displaced UA Scientists with Dual-Use Expertise, and \$85,000 to support of Countering State-Sponsored Nuclear Energy Disinformation through a Ukrainian-Taught Capacity-Building Workshop.
- Approved the 2025 Administrative Operating Budget (AOB) as presented (Total=\$1,221,000), with sharing as follows: USA - \$548,023 and EU - \$672,977.
- Approved the 2025 Supplemental Budgets (SBs) as presented, with \$230,000 assigned to Activities by the USA and €175,000 assigned to Activities by the EU.
- Accepted the 31 December 2023 Financial Statement Audit Report (no 2023 management letter was deemed necessary by the auditors) as presented.
- Approved the 2023 STCU Annual Report as presented.
- Noted introduction of five (5) new Partners to the STCU since the 58th STCU Board of Governors Meeting as follows: University of Oulu (EU), Deutsches Elektronen-Synchrotron (DESY) (EU), Medical Faculty of Lund University (LU) (EU), Universiteit Utrecht (EU), and Appili Therapeutics USA Inc. (USA).
- Confirmed seven (7) new Partner project activities approved since the 58th STCU Board of Governors Meeting for a total of <u>\$1,342,492 and €1,301,544</u>, including: P783 U.S. Department of Energy, (USA) P809 European Office of Aerospace Research and Development, (USA), P811 Deutsches Elektronen-Synchrotron (DESY), (EU), P813 Leibniz Institute for Solid State and Materials Research, (EU), P814 U.S. Department of Energy, (USA), P819 University of Oulu, (EU) and P818 U.S. DoS/ISN/Office of Weapons of Mass Destruction Terrorism (WMDT), (USA); also confirmed eleven (11) Partner project contract extensions with U.S. National Cancer Institute, (P003ac, P004ac1, P004ac1a, P004ac2, P004ac2a, P004ac3, and P004ac3a), USA, Meteorologische Messtechnik GmbH (METEK), (P651g1), EU, G3C Technologies Corporation, (P744b), USA, and Linnaeus University, (P777c), EU, and U.S. DoS/ISN/Office of Weapons of Mass Destruction Terrorism (WMDT), (P782), USA, for a total of <u>\$1,382,780 and €54,000</u>.
